The "Toward Oneness" Project

Jesus desires and our Heavenly Father is working with His loving and gracious power to bring His people to unity in Him. Why, then is it so difficult for us to get together and stay together in our homes, in the Church and in the world? What can we do?

"Toward Oneness" is the theme for our Worship Services and Lifeline Wednesday fellowship adventure for this Fall. There are three levels of involvement in this project, and we are encouraging folks to participate in all three.

1. Sunday Messages will explore Scripture texts that help us to understand both the importance and the difficulties of achieving and maintaining unity in God's family and God's world. We will also look for Biblical guidance toward the goal of greater unity among people.

2. Self-Study Guides with Scripture readings, questions for reflection and guides for meditation will be available each week for individuals to use in their own Bible study.

3. Small Groups will share around the theme of unity with encouragement and direction also provided in the weekly "Oneness Guides." Such small groups will be the focus of our Lifeline Wednesday program this Fall, and we hope you will come and enjoy dinner (5:45), receive a short presentation by Pastor Jay (6:30) and then spend some time sharing and growing with a group of Christian friends (6:45-7:30) each week. As we work Toward Oneness we are moving TO the place God would have us go as His people and moving UP toward Him in cooperation with His eternal and ultimately successful Unity Project. Join us.
